<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Motorized PAC/RAT Chassis	Green olive-drab body housing the internal battery compartment and gear motor.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Rubber Treads	Black flexible continuous rubber tracks wrapped around the drive wheels.
<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Battery Compartment Cover	Small green rectangular hatch sealing the underside or rear battery housing.
<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Control Cable Cord / Tether	Thin wire connecting the unit to the handheld remote controller.
<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Handheld Remote Control Unit	Green control pad with activation switch to operate the motor.
<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Missile Launcher Turret Base	Rotating upper mount where the missile racks attach.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Missile Launch Racks / Arms	Left and right specialized holding rails that elevate the missiles.
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	PAC/RAT Missiles	Small olive-green long tactical missiles slotted into the launch racks. VERY EASY TO LOSE.

MISSING PART TRACKER & INSPECTION ALERT:

The 1983 PAC/RAT series is highly mechanical. Always inspect the battery compartment for damaging acid corrosion. The tiny plastic guide fins on the 4 individual missiles snap off effortlessly, and the black rubber drive treads frequently dry-rot, crack, or split over time.
