Collector's Audit Notice: The Cobra Terror Drome is a massive 360-degree playset. It consists of multiple repetitive sections (walls, base pieces) and dozens of highly fragile click-in parts. Missing door latches, fuel nozzles, and gun chairs drastically impact the market value.
