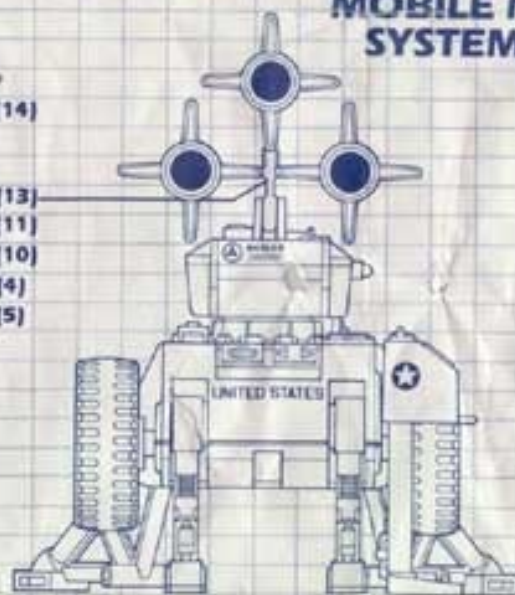
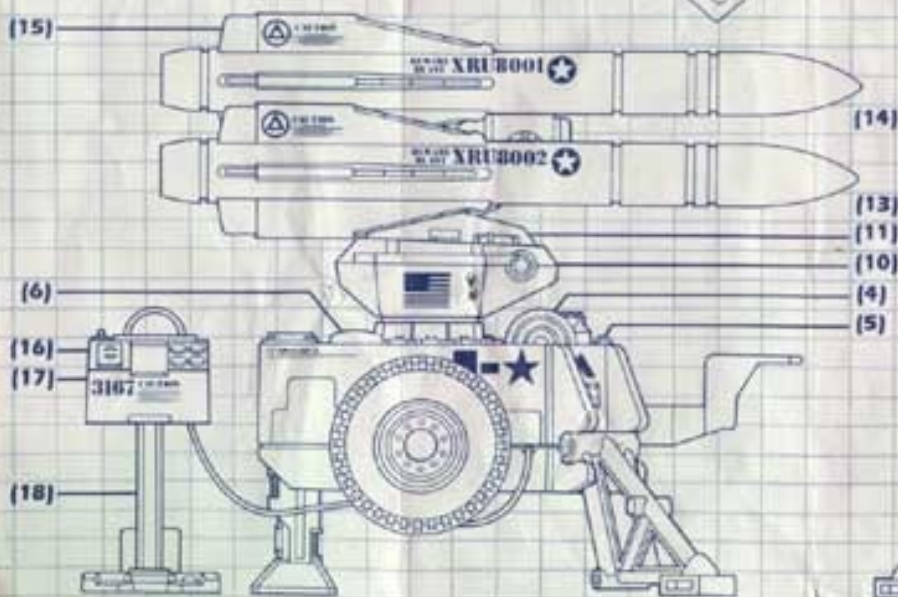


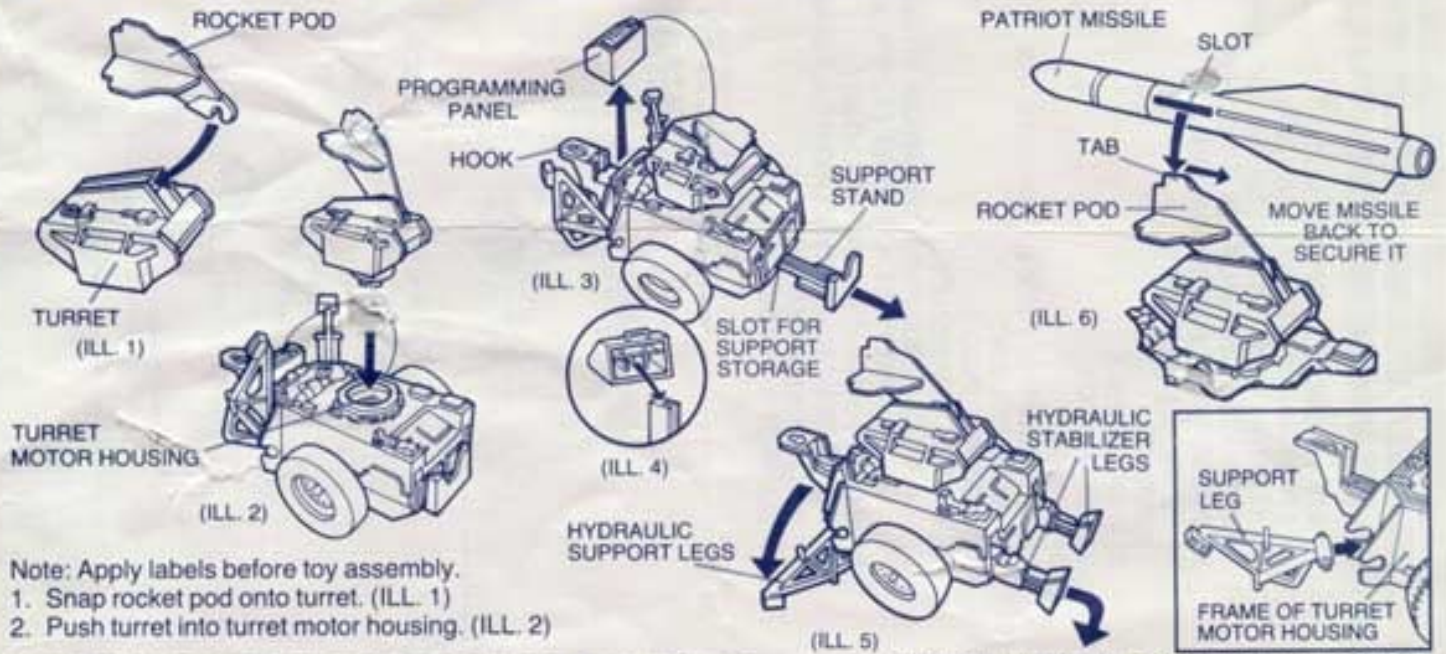

## MOBILE MISSILE SYSTEM "MMS" INSTRUCTIONS



Note: Apply labels before toy assembly.

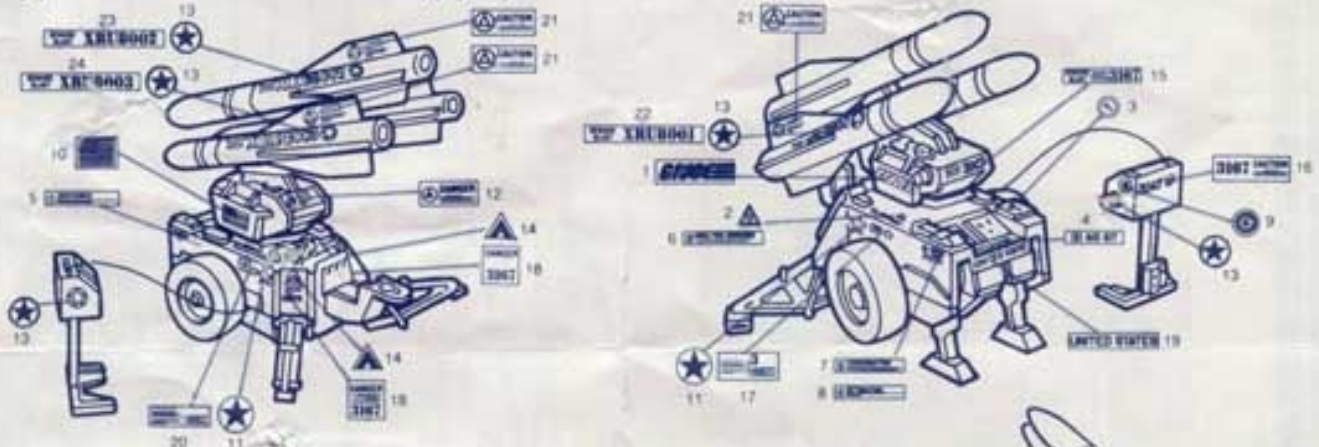
1. Snap rocket pod onto turret. (ILL. 1)
2. Push turret into turret motor housing. (ILL. 2)

### HOW TO PREPARE YOUR "MMS" FOR MISSILE LAUNCHING

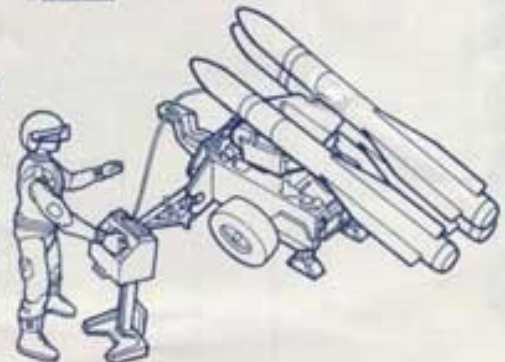
1. Remove support stand from back of housing when preparing the "MMS" for launching. (ILL. 3) Remove programming panel from behind tow hook and snap onto support stand. (ILL. 4) To store support stand, slide support stand all the way into slot at rear of main housing.
2. Fold down hydraulic support legs until they "lock" into place. Pull out and fold down hydraulic stabilizer legs from rear of housing. (ILL. 5)
3. Take each Patriot missile and mount on rocket pod by inserting tab on wing of pod into the wider section of the slot in the missile. Now, pull missile back to secure it on the pod. (ILL. 6)

TO ATTACH SUPPORT LEGS, SIMPLY PRESS EACH LEG BETWEEN FRAMES OF TURRET MOTOR HOUSING, AS SHOWN.

Carefully peel labels from label sheet and apply to your "MMS" as shown in the illustrations.



4. Place G.I. Joe figure at the programming panel and your "MMS" is ready to defend the GI Joe Mobile Strike Force Team against air or tank attack by the evil forces of COBRA Command. "MMS" can be towed into action by "VAMP" or "MOBAT".
